Subject: Changes regarding CPST services via telehealth

On May 22, 2023, LDH received CMS approval to allow Community Psychiatric Support and Treatment (CPST) services via telehealth. This approval was made effective May 1, 2023, thus allowing uninterrupted CPST telehealth services to Louisiana residents. Providers may continue to bill CPST services with the telehealth modifier, when the below clinical considerations, telehealth guidelines and communication requirements are met. The Medicaid Behavioral Health Services Provider Manual is currently being updated to reflect the CPST telehealth allowance.

If you sent claims to Magellan for CPST conducted via telehealth, using modifier 95 and the correct place of service, for the time period of May 12, 2023, forward, your claims will be reprocessed on your behalf once our systems have been updated to reflect this change.
